General Advising Notes

There are three different advisors with whom you must discuss your degree requirements: Major, Minor, and General Education. You need to be in touch with each advisor to be sure you have all requirements covered. Be sure to keep copies of all paperwork and have advisors sign off at each stage of your career.

Two requirements that often are lost in the shuffle of details are:

- Total number of units required is 120.
- Total number of upper division (300 and 400 level) units required is 42.

You must go through the degree check process no later than your second to the last semester in order to verify that you have met all degree requirements so that you can make any necessary adjustments to your final semester(s).

If you have transferred to the UA from another institution, there are requirements about how many units must be taken here at the UA. ("A minimum of 30 units of University Credit from the University of Arizona is required for the bachelor's degree. It is further required that 18 of the final 30 units offered toward the degree be University Credit.")
